- Board of Education Report (Mary Lou Lauchert)
 - Budget passed overwhelmingly (599-115).
 - Two new board members for next year: Sam Catterson and Melinda Leising.
- Principals' Reports
 - Dr. Carney (Middle School) – approximately 150 people went (students, teachers, parents) to NYC. Trip ties into curriculum (ELA, history): USS Intrepid and 9/11 Memorial.
 - Mrs. Leuthauser (Elementary School) – new: Fun Day! Flag Day and 5th grade ceremony are coming up. Capital Project – changes in the physical space. Events that normally occur in the school may not be able to happen in the building. Mrs. Leuthauser would like to meet over the summer and discuss options or possible locations before the calendar comes out. Meetings with NY State in July. Class list reveal day – there will be a bus available for incoming kindergarteners to take a practice ride. She'd like to have the drivers available to meet students. Date not finalized – probably 3rd week in August.
